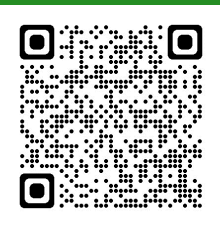
Winter Regulations

Contractors requiring water for projects and requesting connection to a hydrant must obtain approval from the DPW Superintendent. Approved connections will incur the Outside Village Customer Charge and usage charge for all water used. Billing will occur monthly.

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors

All buildings, whether it's a home, office or public place, need to have smoke and carbon monoxide detectors installed. You can choose to have separate detectors for each or a combination detector that detects both. These detectors can be connected to your electrical system or powered by batteries, or even a combination of both.

Detectors should be placed:

- Bedrooms
- Hallways
- 1st floor exterior entrances
- Attics
- Central locations
- At least 1 per floor

It is recommended that carbon monoxide detectors be installed at a height of approximately five feet from the ground. Ensure your building is equipped with the appropriate detectors to prioritize the safety of those inside.
